No restrictions




As captain, you have full control from the helmsman's position, while remaining in close contact with the rest of the boat's interior.


The flying bridge is also fully equipped and gives you exactly the overview you require.
















Going places in style and comfort

The Storebro Royal Cruiser 430 Baltic is a safe and seaworthy boat. It is also a beautiful and stylish boat. But its good looks are not just beauty for beauty's sake. The boat is designed to provide maximum pleasure and all the comforts of home to people who spend much of their leisure time at sea. So functionality and practical qualities set the tone, with design solutions rooted in a solid tradition of craftsmanship.

The interior is typical Storebro – perfection down to the minutest detail, velvet-smooth wooden surfaces and matching fabrics of the highest quality. The handmade woodwork is crafted in classic marine grade mahogany.

The well-equipped galley is located amidship, in direct contact with the saloon just a few steps up. The worktop is available in a choice of hardwearing Corian (standard) or handsome mahogany. The location of the galley and its open-plan design make it a spacious and easy to work in – ideal for preparing favourite meals and adventurous culinary delights for both family and guests. And if the sea breezes don't sharpen your appetite, the layout and equipment of the galley certainly will.













Freedom of choice


The layout of the boat ensures a comfortable, functional environment, with maximum use made of every inch of space to make life on board as easy as possible.

There is a clear distinction between the sleeping quarters and the areas intended for entertaining and socialising.

The spacious owner's cabin, which is located in the stern, has a double bed with a fully sprung mattress specially made for the marine environment, a separate WC and shower, double cupboards and plenty of storage space.

The large guest cabin, located in the bow, has a double bed with a fully sprung mattress, private shower/WC, cupboard space and excellent storage space. Extra storage space is provided under the easy-lift bed top.

The sleeping quarters have all the comforts and privacy you need to enjoy life on board. If you need more sleeping space for guests, you can opt for a layout with an extra guest cabin (two berths) instead of a dining area. The dining area can, of course, be used as a temporary sleeping space at any time.





Lots of extra stowage space beneath the easy-lift bed top in the roomy guest cabin in the bow. A gas-filled strut makes it easy to lift and lower the "lid". The storage space is lit for extra convenience.






The guest cabin has its own separate WC, wash basin and storage space, as well as a comfortable shower compartment with ample room for standing or sitting.




The elegantly fitted and very spacious owner's cabin, located in the stern, has a wide, comfortable double bed, separate WC and shower and two large cupboards.

The mid-ship dinette can also be replaced by an extra guest cabin for two people.









The year was 1728. Sixty kilometres from the sea, in the Province of Småland in southern Sweden, a tiny foundry was set up.

The drop hammer forged pig iron smelted from ore dredged from local lakes and mires. Some of the iron was cast into ship's bells, many of which sounded the watches on the great sailing ships. Thus began the story of Storebro Bruk and its long and sometimes adventurous voyage into the present.
