She is built on an attractive V-shaped hull with the classic lines characteristic of Storebro's boat building tradition.

Storebro Royal Cruiser 430 Baltic not only makes it possible to enjoy your time at sea but also gives you the unique opportunity to search for new, unforgettable experiences and moments to treasure.



The master cabin at the stern of the boat is roomy and elegant. A large double bed with a real coil-spring mattress is specially designed for being at sea. There is an en suite WC and shower, as well as two full-length, generous wardrobes.

Practical features and functionality set the tone on the Storebro Royal Cruiser 430 Baltic. But she is certainly not lacking elegance or beauty. Quite the opposite. The interior houses all of Storebro's hallmark characteristics – the luxurious hand-crafted wooden interior with smooth wooden surfaces that are tastefully combined with the highest quality textiles and materials.

A quick glance at the layout will tell you that this is a boat built for comfort. Below deck you will find, the roomy master cabin at the stern, an equally spacious guest cabin in the bow, an open well-planned galley with en suite dinette and a roomy WC and shower compartments. On the upper deck there is the elegant saloon and fully-equipped helmsman and navigator positions.

The saloon offers plenty of space for family and friends. The fixed, spacious sofa can seat up to six people. The front part of the sofa can be folded out into a comfortable navigator's sofa. And with Storebro's range of colours and textiles, you can add your own personal touch to the interior.

A well-planned galley equipped with a double sink, double cutting boards, a refrigerator, a stove with an oven and an abundance of storage space. There is also space for a freezer. The galley's design allows the chef to converse freely with the guests without having to reveal the secrets of his/her cooking. Directly opposite the galley there is the cosy dinette which can be used as a temporary sleeping space if required. This area can also be specified as a permanent guest cabin with twin berths *(option)*.





Located half a flight up on the saloon, the aft deck is the perfect place for sunbathing and socializing. There is a built-in staircase at the stern that provides easy access to the wide swim platform.

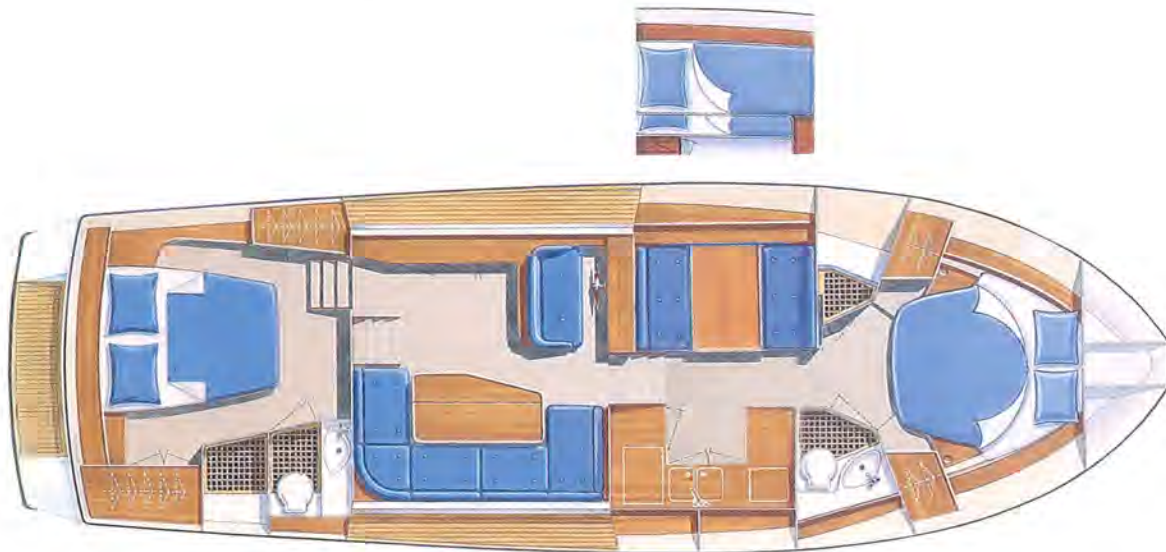


The flying bridge has fully-equipped helmsman and navigator positions, as well as, a comfortable sofa for passengers. There is a staircase conveniently leading from the aft deck to the flying bridge.



The guest cabin is located at the bow of the vessel. It also houses Storebro's comfortable double bed and has an en suite WC/shower and wardrobes. Under the easy-lift bed you will also find a very generous stowage space.

HULL, DECK AND SUPERSTRUCTURE

Isophthalic gelcoat. Hand-laid fiberglass with horizontal deck surfaces and topsides of hull in Sandwich construction. Hull below waterline in single-skin laminate.

Selected mahogany with satin finish varnish in Khaya mahogany.
