With her tough, tried-and-tested construction, she is not limited by anything except your own knowledge and seamanship.

The equipment on-board is more than adequate and all the features have been made with traditional craftsmanship. From bow to aft she is filled with ingenious and elegant solutions all designed to make life on board comfortable, safe and as simple as possible.





The 430 Biscay's most distinguishing feature is not her beautifully designed exterior but the roomy, well-planned interior. We have concentrated on creating an open atmosphere onboard and a flow through the boat's dining and working areas. That is why the Biscay 430 has a very spacious flying bridge and why the saloon and aft deck are on the same level. There is also an open, well-planned and well-equipped galley right next to the saloon.

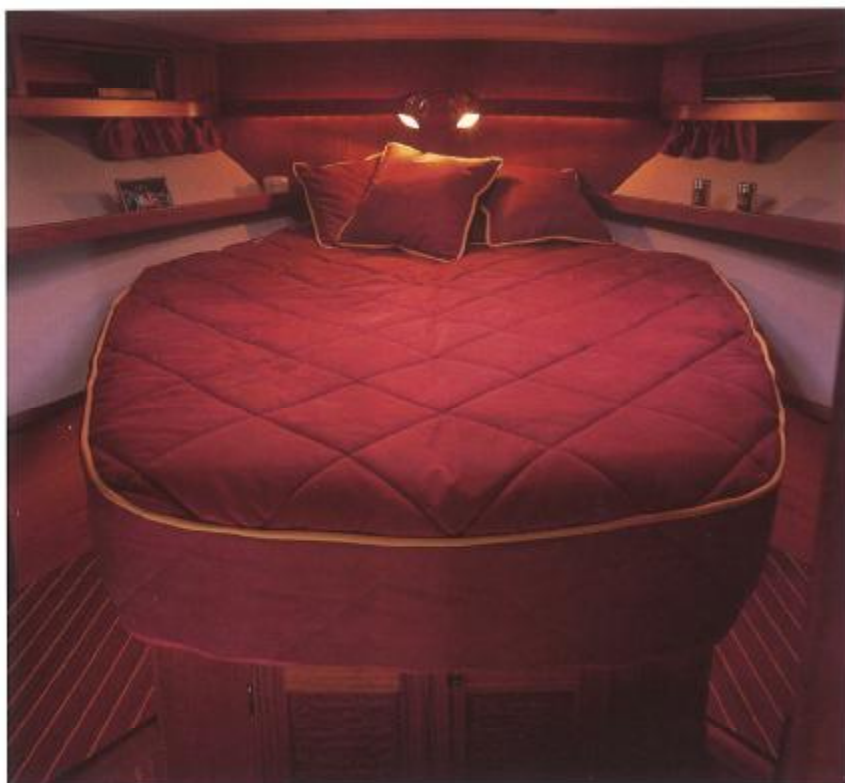
By placing the master and guest cabins in the boat's bow, there is a clear division between the vessel's private and public quarters. The sleeping quarters are given necessary privacy. The spacious master cabin is located in the bow and the guest cabin amidships on the port side.

In the interior, you'll find Storebro's trademark – superior woodwork combined with high-quality matching textiles. All with the Storebro's functional design.

The saloon offers plenty of space to accommodate the entire family and guests. The fixed, comfortable sofa can seat up to 6 people. The chairs can be moved to create even more space around the table. Add your personal touch; choose from Storebro's selection of exquisite textiles and colours.

In the guest cabin there are two separate single beds with the same high-quality coil-spring mattress found in the master cabin. The guest cabin also has an en suite WC/shower.



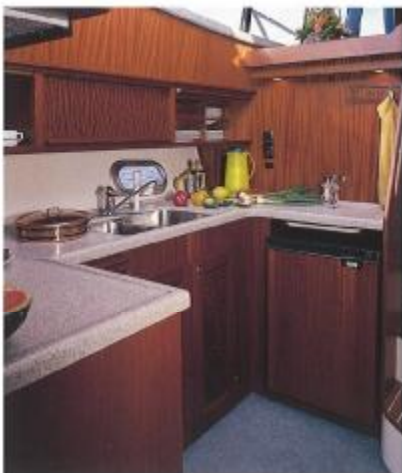
The roomy master cabin houses a large double bed with a real coil-spring mattress. There is also an abundance of stowage space including two wardrobes, of which one is full-length.

The cabin has its own washroom and WC/shower en suite.





The 430 Biscay has a large flying bridge with beautiful, rounded forms. It includes a large, L-shaped passenger sofa as well as the fully-equipped helmsman and navigator's positions. There is also lots of space for sunbathing and relaxing. The bridge's extended length also provides welcome shade for the aft deck. A cover can easily be unravelled from the discrete storage spaces under the flying bridge.



A panoramic glass window, with an extra-wide sliding glass door, separates the saloon and aft deck. A perfect area for socializing. The glass window not only offers a breathtaking view aft but also offers light and creates a feeling of spaciousness.



The well-equipped galley includes a double sink, double cutting boards, a refrigerator and a stove with an oven. There is also space for a freezer. The galley also has plenty of extra stowage space.

The galley's location, just a few steps down from the saloon, allows the chef to converse freely with the guests without having to reveal the secrets of his/her cooking.

Hand-laid fiberglass with horizontal deck surfaces and topside of hull in Sandwich construction. Hull below waterline in single-skin laminate. Isophthalic gelcoat.

Selected mahogany with satin finish varnish in Khaya mahogany.
