Storebro Bruks AB was originally founded in year 1728, when a hammer forge was erected for the processing of iron ore fished out of the nearby lakes. Also a blast furnace, a flour- and saw mill was built and last but not least a small foundry. This gradually developed into a modern industry which today employs around 500 people, divided in two separate divisions - machine tools and boats.

Machine tool production has been a main activity since the beginning of this century. The boat production was started in 1945 with small rowing and fishing boats.

Skilful workers in Storebro and Västervik see to that machine- and boat building traditions lives and make it possible for the products to correspond to the high demands of the Storebro customers.



Sub-contracting is offered to some customers from the foundry and sheet-metal work shops.




