
The hull – hefty bottom beam stringers and sturdy rudder fastenings. Nothing has been spared to ensure the hull is as seaworthy and solid as possible.

A craft in which you can make the most of your seagoing life. Far away from the telephone and everyday stress and strain. Having fun with good friends, making new friends. The deck salon will be a faceourite gathering place from morning till night.

A boat for stretching out the yachting season as far as possible. Warm and comfortable behind the large sliding doors with sea and Mother Nature just outside.

The glassfibre reinforced plastic hard-top hatch slides easily back and forth depending on the kind of weather you're getting.

Putting out to sea is doubly enjoyable when your boat is perfectly planned. Take the galley. Every detail, every surface exploited to maximum. The quiet running refrigerator uses very little electricity. It's placed within easy reach of the cooker. Hot and cold water from a tank holding 200 litres. Especially designed cabinets for glass and china behind sliding mahogany doors. (Storebro-crockery optional.) Efficient, concealed strip lighting plus adjustable lighting. Cup-boards over cooker and sink. Cutting board. Well fitted cupboards and drawers. All fittings characterized by high quality carpentry.

The boat can be equipped with a two burner paraffin stove or a two burner gas stove with an oven.

Biscay is also available with flying bridge.



Dressing table with mirror. Wardrobe. Discreet, effective lighting. Good ventilation. All for a sound, comfortable night's sleep.

The after cabin roof is a wonderful sun-terrace and popular "look-out" place. This version of the Storebro Royal Cruiser 31 will sleep six adults for long comfortable voyaging.

Bathroom with toilet, hot and cold water, opening window, corner washbasin and efficient shower with hot and cold water. An important contribution to life aboard. A teak lattice set in the floor uncovers the shower water waste, complete with electrical pump.

Successful long voyages are not solely dependent on well-planned fittings. More important still is being secure in the knowledge that your craft is built safely and strongly from bow to stern. Storebro have always held safety details in great respect – rather one too many than one too few.

An example – there's a 125 liter per minute capacity manual pump for emergencies as well as two electrical bilge pumps. The manual pump covers the entire bilge area.

A Storebro exclusive, a well filled service box beneath the dinette. Contains distress signals, first aid kit, tools, pump impeller, filler kit, oil filter, hand lamp, etc.

The engine room is spacious and accessible. All installations are easily inspected and serviced. It contains the pump central and water heater unit. The fuel tanks hold 325 liters each.

Automatic anchor windlass optional.

The cockpit is equipped with compartments for charts, navigation instruments, autopilot etc. The instrument panel features electric switches which doubles as circuit breakers.

Standard equipment

DECK:

2 pairs stainless mooring cleats — toughened glass in all outward facing windows — 2 windscreen wipers — internationelly approved navigation lights — boat hook — ensign staff — jackstaff (Biscay) — grab rails — stainless bathing ladder — pulpit with tenderholders — compressor horn.

FOREPEAK:

2 V-shaped berths, stowage space beneath — wardrobe — deck hatsh.

SALON:

Port mouted U-shaped dinett. Height adjustable table. The dinett converts easily into a double berth. Galley with room for two burner cooker or two burner cooker with oven — stainless steel sink — hot and cold water pressure system to sink — cutting board — holders for glass and china — electric refregerator — kit box beneath sofa contains first aid kit, distress signals, tolos, spare engine parst etc.

BATHROOM:

Washbasin and shower, hot and cold pressure water — WC — stowage locker — opening window for ventilation.

COCKPIT, DECKSALON:

Full engine instrumentation - fuel gauge - engine controls - teleflex steering - manual bilge pump -

helmsman's seat — navigator's seat (in Biscy sofa to starboard which converts to two berths) — selfdraining cockpit — fire extinguisher — ashtrays — sliding hatch in hard top (Biscay) — compass — sumlog — Trimtabs electro hydraulic.

AFTER CABIN: (Baltic only)

Two extra-wide berths – wardrobe – 2×140 l polyethene freschwater tanks beneath the forward part of teh berths – bookshelves.

ENGINE ROOM:

Flexibly mounted engines, - glassfibre spill tray beneath engines - alternator, water separating fuel filter, salt water filter for each engine - three electric bilge pumps - fresch water pump - fuel tanks 2×325 l.

MISCELLAENOUS:

Cushions, curtains and fitted carpets. Generous lighting troughout. Power points for hand lamp. Batteries. Curved frontpanels for extra strenght. The boat is delivered with a certificate from Det Norske Veritas. Anchor 15 kg. Anchorline. 6 fenders. 4 mooring-lines.
