All models feature a bathroom. Hot and cold water washbasin, powerful hot and cold water shower, opening window, teak lattice floor. These uncompromisingly well-fitted heads contribute magnificently to the comfort of life aboard.

The forepeak is fitted out with berths, ample stowage space, bookshelves, a door for privacy, deck hatch and a generous sized wardrobe.

In the Baltic the after-cabin will accommodate two adults, crew or guests. Or could be used as parent-free accommodation for a number of youngsters. Dressing table with mirror. Good ventilation, all important to a comfortable night's sleep. Plenty of stowage space, bookshelves and a large wardrobe.





f you would now follow us on deck. Demanding and critical boat owners the world over consider that the Storebro yard builds the most beautiful motor cruisers ever launched. Classic lines, extreme comfort and uncompromising quality make your Storebro Royal Cruiser 31 an investment unprecedented among resent-day pleasure craft. Putting out to sea is doubly enjoyable when your boat is properly built and planned.

The helmsman's position with all controls within easy reach, easy to ead instruments, large chart tables in front of both helmsman and navigator, provide maximum navigation control. The solid and impeccable workmanship of the cockpit, heavy aluminium window frames throughout and curved, safety glass windscreens provide the helmsman with excellent visibility and an impregnable sense of security and well-being. The built-in drinking glass holders, fitted ashtrays and powerful wipers are standard. Defroster and windscreen washers are available as extras.

The cockpit will also serve as an admirable deck salon and favourite gathering place. The Biscay version, with sliding hatch, seating you secure and warm behind the large, sliding safety glass door, is a boat for stretching out the yachting season as far as

possible. The mahogany cockpit fittings as shown here are standard in the Storebro Royal Cruiser 31 de Luxe.

The Adriatic's afterdeck is a sunbather's dream, sheltered from the wind and entirely open to the sun.

The Biscay deck lounge sofa trans-




forms into comfortable berths. The afterdeck is sheltered by windbreaks and has space enough for table and chairs, which can be stowed away beneath the teak flooring. Butler's Tray table and deckchairs are standard.

The Baltic after cabin roof makes a wonderful sun-bathing area and a

popular vantage spot.

As always, the practical and thoughtful detail makes it abundantly clear that this is a craft of solid and ultimate quality. The foredeck, for example, with pulpit fender holder, strategically placed locker for ropes, etc., anchor line stemhead roller and forepeak safety hatch. The Targa radar mast as illustrated is optional equipment.





Beauty lies not only in the clean lines, but in the power and precision behind them. The Storebro Royal Cruiser is powered by your choice of twin Volvo Penta engines to give you added safety. Whatever your choice this cruiser will attain a more than adequate rate of knots.

Special safety features include separate fuel tanks and fuel systems, separate electrical systems for each engine, separate cooling intake and cooling system. Sound insulation is very effective and the 4 or 5 bladed propellers turn silently, without vibration.

Exhaust outlets lead beneath the surface for quiet, exhaust-free running.

The engine room is spacious and, since the floor can be completely lifted away, accessible, with all installations easily inspected and serviced.

The well-filled tool box, a notable example of Storebro attention to detail, contains touch-up paint, distress flares, first-aid kit, block gasket, oil-filter, impeller, injector, spare lamp bulbs, etc... This is fitted beneath the dinette seat cushions.

Storebro's electrical distribution box is truly unique. Direct cables run to each, individual electrical output point. There are no junctions or terminals outside the box. Automatic fuses have been silver-plated to avoid corrosion. All cables are numbered throughout the boat. And, finally, a most efficient earthing system protects all vital metal parts built into the boat from corrosion.







B ecause these cruisers have been designed to make your enjoyment of coastal and offshore cruising as complete as possible, particular care has been applied to provide you with absolute safety and maximum seaworthiness.

The semi-planing hull makes for easy going in heavy weather. Designed to take the tougher conditions out to sea, this is the hull supplied to Police, Coastguard, Navy and off-shore companies.

The power, speed and seaworthiness of the Storebro Royal Cruiser is matched only by the ease with which she can negotiate narrow waterways.

The boat responds to the throttle and helm with assured precision.


Built with the quality consciousness and traditions which have established the respect and succes which Storebro cruisers enjoy among seafaring folk everywhere, it's nice to know your craft is constructed safely and strongly from stem to stern. The hull is handlaid with an entirely separate fibreglass frame which is bonded to the hull. This ensures accurate positioning on each boat and avoids the use of foam filling and provides immense strength. Delivered with a certificate from Det Norske Veritas.

Storebro have always considered safety to be of the upmost importance,



and this is shown in every aspect of construction. An example of this policy is the 125 litre per minute capacity, manual bilge pump, covering the entire bilge area, in addition to the three electrical pumps.
