
ROYAL CRUISER 42



ROYAL CRUISER 42

is the latest motor cruiser from Storebro Bruk, who are also the builders of the Royal Cruiser 34 (IV), the best selling boat of its size and class in Europe and winner of the open sea section of the 1968 Pavillon d'Or.

The Royal Cruiser 42 has many of the same features as her sisters, well-known for their sea going qualities. She has a round bilge semi-displacement hull with efficient spray rails and bilge keels to give the ultimate in dry, soft and stable riding even in tre roughest weather conditions.

With the exception of a helmsman's seat the large deck saloon is bare to allow the buyer to fit out this important section of the craft to his own tastes. The aft staircase in the deck saloon its two side berths. This, the owner's cabin, offers all facilities such as a sit-down bathtub in one compartment and basin and W.C. in another. There are three full-length lockers, many drawers and a dressing table with large mirror. In the forward saloon you will find the galley which has space for a two-burner stove. A 2.3 cu.ft. electric refrigerator, sink, drawers, lockers and cutting board are fitted. The U-shaped settee, convertible into a comfortable double berth, offers seating for seven.

A separate toilet with washbasin and W.C. is opposite a full length locker and these divide the forward saloon from the fore cabin in which are two berths with lockers under.

All floors are covered with carpets giving a luxurious feeling and added sound insulation.

A heat exchanger on one engine's cooling system supplies hot water throughout the vessel under pressure.
